



IQAC Report

After the NAAC Assessment and Accreditation of the College in 2011, IQAC undertook many evaluative steps to provide leadership and guidance to the institution. In order to supplement the traditional system of teaching -learning, IQAC insisted on application of latest ICT equipments and devices and accordingly, the authority installed such devices within a very short span of time for the benefit of both students and teaching community. Among them, the most notable was installation of Digital and Interactive Multimedia Facility along with Green Boards and Whiteboards in the classrooms. Under the UGC-CPE advancement programmes, IQAC took active part with the college authority to set up an e-learning resource centre and sophisticated databank in the central library. At the behest of the the IQAC, the college authority also entered into an agreement with a leading Publication establishment for the opening of a Bibliophilia Café, an online library and e-resource centre, which now provides access to more than one lakh journals and research cum learning materials to students, researchers as well as teachers. Towards the end of the academic year, the website team of the IQAC successfully launched a state -of -the- art website of the college, www.drcollege.org to show what lies inside to the outside world.

BIBLIOPHILIA CAFÉ

The Bibliophilia Café was established in March, 2012 and became operative from this academic year 2011-12. The Bibliophilia Café, an e-content library and Book Store, provides premier online research tool for academic use. The café delivers trusted digital content of more than one lakh journals and learning materials and around 2,000 magazines. It delivers content from books, journals, magazines, newspapers like JSTOR, EBSCO, Pro Quest, Gale Research, Springer Link, Science Direct, Wiley Inter science, Cambridge Journal Online, Oxford University and many more. New articles are added daily to the articles archive and the extensive article archive dates back to the 1980s. A regular member can browse the internet, get a print out of reading materials and even have photocopies in the document centre at affordable and nominal rates.




